He studied marketing and found success in a rewarding career in healthcare, designing equipment for the handicapped, such as grab bars and other assistive devices. Alan also found great fulfillment in his volunteer work. He was a regular volunteer with a reading service for blind individuals, providing a vital connection through his voice. In addition, he managed the suicide prevention hotline for his church, offering support to those in need. Alan also contributed his time to House of Hope, where he worked to make a difference in the lives of others, always driven by his strong sense of compassion and service. Meanwhile, Janet devoted much of her time to their children and grandchildren.

They are the proud parents of two children: their son David, who lives in Michigan, and their daughter Debbie, who resides in the sunshine state of Florida. Janet and Alan light up with emotion and excitement when they talk about their family. They cherish their nine grandchildren—six girls and three boys—and are overjoyed to have two great-granddaughters, with another bundle of joy expected in December.

However, due to health issues, they now spend most of their time indoors. To stay sharp and entertained, they enjoy playing online games daily, including Wordle, Scrabble, and poker, and often challenge each other on Brain Challenge. When they're not gaming, they love watching their favorite TV shows, Dancing with the Stars and The Floor, which bring them plenty of joy and excitement.

They have been happily married for over 60 years now, often reminiscing about their wedding day in 1963. The weather was a frigid 8 degrees below zero—talk about cold for young hearts! Despite the freezing temperatures, their love has remained warm and strong for decades, a bond that has only deepened over the years.
